In Matthew's Gospel, we see these two women, in the midst of their pain and loss, going to the tomb to weep, to mourn and to comfort one another. Yet it was also here that they met with the risen Lord.

What I have been reflecting on though, is that on both this occasion and when He appears to the disciples a short time later,

He comforts them and then gives them a job to do - *Go and tell*.

This Easter time, whether the sun is shining in our lives or the clouds have just rolled in, the invitation we have is to meet with the risen Lord Jesus afresh. May we hear those words in our lives *Do not be afraid* but also hear the second part of the conversation *Go and tell*.

I wonder who you are being asked by Jesus to go and tell - a family member, a friend or a work colleague perhaps? Jesus is risen! He takes away our fear, but He also gives us a job to do. May you hear these words afresh this Easter time.
